



# How Can I Become a Board of Health Member?

## What is the Board of Health?

The Board of Health is the governing body of Clermont County Public Health and has the authority to adopt rules and regulations and enact policies within the agency.




## Who is on the Board of Health?

Five members make up the Board of Health. Each member serves a five-year term. At least one of the members must be a physician.


## When are the meetings?

Meetings are on the second Wednesday of each month at 3:30 p.m. at Public Health's administrative offices at 2275 Bauer Road in Batavia.



## How are members chosen?

The Clermont County District Advisory Council (DAC) appoints members to the the Clermont County Board of Health. The DAC is established under section 3709.03 of the Ohio Revised Code and consists of the board of county commissioners president, the chairperson from each township's board of trustees, and the mayor of each village in Clermont County. The council meets each March to appoint a member to the board of health.



Candidates for a board of health position must be appointed by a member of the District Advisory Council. Anyone interested in serving on the board of health should contact a DAC member to discuss their qualifications and attend the annual DAC meeting in March.
