

The Board of Health of the Clermont County General Health District met in regular session on the 14th day of October 2026, with the following members present:

Resolution Establishing Revised License Fees for Risk Levels I, II, III, and IV Food Service Operations or Retail Food Establishments; Vending Food Service; Temporary Food Service Operations or Retail Food Establishments; Mobile Low-Risk Food Service Operations or Retail Food Establishments; Mobile High-Risk Food Service Operations or Retail Food Establishments; Individual Public Swimming Pools, Public Spas, or Special Use Pools; Government or Tax Supported School Swimming Pools, Spas, or Special Use Pools; Recreational Vehicle Parks, Recreation Camps, Combined Park Camps; Temporary Recreational Vehicle Parks, Recreation Camps, or Combined Park Camps; Tattooing, Body Piercing or Combined Body Art Service Establishments; Resident Camps; Plumbing; Septic; Replacement International Certificate of Vaccination Card; and Returned ACH Penalty Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3709.09 and 3709.21.

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Clermont County General Health District has the authority, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 3709.09 and 3709.21, to establish a uniform system of fee services; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Clermont County General Health District is mandated to provide services that protect the public health and prevent or restrict disease, and abate or suppress nuisances; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Clermont County General Health District has determined that it is necessary to revise the license fees for Risk Levels I, II, III, and IV Food Service Operations or Retail Food Establishments; Vending Food Service; Temporary Food Service Operations or Retail Food Establishments; Mobile Low-Risk Food Service Operations or Retail Food Establishments; Mobile High-Risk Food Service Operations or Retail Food Establishments; Individual Public Swimming Pools, Public Spas, or Special Use Pools; Government or Tax Supported School Swimming Pools, Spas, or Special Use Pools; Recreational Vehicle Parks, Recreation Camps, Combined Park Camps; Temporary Recreational Vehicle Parks, Recreation Camps, or Combined Park Camps; Tattooing, Body Piercing or Combined Body Art Service Establishments; Resident Camps; Plumbing; Septic; Replacement International Certificate of Vaccination or Prophylaxis (ICVP); and Returned ACH Penalty and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Clermont County General Health District did direct the Health Commissioner to notify all entities that would be affected by the proposed fee at least 20 days prior to the September 9, 2026, Board of Health meeting, at which time a public hearing on the revised fees was held; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Clermont County General Health District finds that the Health Commissioner did notify all entities that would be affected by the proposed fees as directed by this Board at least twenty (20) days prior to the September 9, 2026 Board meeting, which was prior to the passage of this resolution establishing the revised fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Health of the Clermont County General Health District, that license fees for the following services be revised as stated:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Risk Levels I, II, III, and IV Food Service Operations or Retail Food Establishments; Vending Food Service; Temporary Food Service Operations or Retail Food Establishments; Mobile Low-Risk Food Service Operations or Retail Food Establishments; Mobile High-Risk Food Service Operations or Retail Food Establishments; Individual Public Swimming Pools, Public Spas, or Special Use Pools; Government or Tax Supported School Swimming Pools, Spas, or Special Use Pools; Recreational Vehicle Parks, Recreation Camps, Combined Park Camps; Temporary Recreational Vehicle Parks, Recreation Camps, or Combined Park Camps; Tattooing, Body Piercing or Combined Body Art Service Establishments; Resident Camps fees revised pursuant to this Resolution hereby become effective on December 1, 2026, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Plumbing; Septic; Replacement International Certificate of Vaccination or Prophylaxis (ICVP); and Returned ACH Penalty fees revised pursuant to this Resolution hereby become effective on January 1, 2027.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Board of Health of the Clermont County General Health District, that the revised fees be recorded and certified to become part of the record of local regulation by the Board of Health of the Clermont County General Health District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by this Board of Health of the Clermont County General Health District, that the advertisement of such rules be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the health district once a week for two consecutive weeks or as provided for in R.C. § 7.16 and that such rules shall take effect and be in force ten days from the date of the first publication.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this Board of Health of the Clermont County General Health District finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board and that all deliberations of this Board and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance of the applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
